COLORADO PAID FAMILY AND MEDICAL LEAVE INSURANCE PROGRAM (FAMLI)

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PEETZ, COLORADO, DECLARING THE TOWN OF PEETZ'S DECISION TO OPT OUT OF THE COLORADO PAID FAMILY AND MEDICAL LEAVE INSURANCE PROGRAM (FAMLI)

WHEREAS, the C.R.S. § 8-13.3-522 provides that a local government employers may participation in the FAMLI program by vote of the governing body; and

WHEREAS, participation in FAMLI will significantly increase the Town's annual budget, the program raises employer liability concerns, FAMLI is a new program with rules not yet fully established, and it is the recommendation of the Colorado program, and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Peetz Town Council to decline participation in the program.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PEETZ, COLORADO THAT:

- Section 1. The foregoing recitals are incorporated herein as if set forth in full and are adopted as findings.
- Section 2. The Town of Peetz hereby declines participation in the Colorado Paid Family and Medical Leave Insurance Program.
- Section 3. Notice of this Declaration shall be provided to the Colorado Division of Labor and Employment.
